

Volkswagen ID.7, ID.7 Tourer Type ED2, ED5 02.2024 -

How to select the correct coil spring for your vehicle !

The ID.7 is equipped with drive batteries with various capacities and electric motors with different power ratings. The quickest and most reliable way to select the correct replacement coil spring for your vehicle is explained here.

Colour code and marking on the spring

Original front coil springs for the ID.7 carry a colour code that can be used to identify the original part number of the coil spring that was factory-installed in the vehicle. The colour code can be seen without removing the spring from the vehicle, as shown in the photo below.

Rear coil springs do not carry a colour code but, instead, a white label that shows the original equipment part number of the coil spring.

This label is more difficult to access and requires the vehicle to be raised on a lift and approached from the rear in order to read it.

Use the front- and rear coil spring tables shown below to select the correct ERL reference for your vehicle.

Spring Seat for the Front Coil Spring



Eibach recommends replacing the lower spring seat (OE-No. 5Q0 412 545 D) where the front spring locates on the damper whenever new front coil springs are installed.

This rubber spring seat prevents metal-to-metal contact between the coil spring and the damper plate, thus extending the service life of the coil spring.

In addition, it serves to reduce noise transmission into the vehicle interior.

This spring seat is subject to wear and tear and should be inspected and replaced if damaged.

Spring Seat for the Rear Coil Spring



Eibach supplies rear coil springs for the ID.7 with a clip-on rubber spring seat that locates in a plastic retaining cup at the lower end of the coil spring. This cup can be easily removed from the defective coil spring and, after cleaning and inspection, should be fitted to the spring seat supplied with the Eibach coil spring. The plastic retaining cup is not subject to wear, but should be inspected for damage and replaced if necessary. New plastic retaining cups are available from VW under the part number 1EA 512 297.
